Dave writes class tune

Trenton High School's Class of '79 has a unique theme song—a tune composed by its class president, Dave Caruso.

The song, appropriately titled "Class Song," is the first tune written by a member of a senior class as the group's special song.

"In the past, there have been some very good choices for class songs but I wanted to write something for my class that more specifically expresses how a lot of us feel right now," Dave said.

"At first, I wasn't even sure how to go about getting it nominated," Dave recalled. "My brothers gave me a lot of ideas to help promote the song, including getting it pressed into a re-

cord so that seniors can have something to help them remember high school. The class song record was available in the latter part of May."

The Caruso Brothers have been performing concerts and wedding receptions in the area for several years.

Mike Caruso is 20 years old and is a junior at the University of Michigan, Dearborn where he is editor of the school newspaper. The other members of the group are Joe, 19, and Rob, 15.

The senior class song has not been Dave's only accomplishment. Both sides of the Caruso Brother's latest single release were penned by Dave. The songs on the record are called "The Game" and "Rainy Day Lullaby."
